Activity 4

Ward Level Orientation and WaLC Action Planning workshop

Number of Events: 150

Dates: 1st August to 25th August

- Formation of a ward level core team to design the location/ colony/basti level activities.
- Members of the Ward Level Core team are Community Organiser (CO convenor)_, HMWSSB Manager (Convenor) , SLF Leaders (2), WaLC Champions (2) , Environment officer
- Role of the Ward Level core team is to ensure that the location wise events are planned, implemented and communicated to the Circle level core team. Further the team must ensure that there is clear coordination and communication with the central core team , NGOs and WaLC volunteers
- Orientation to be given on WaLC concept, about HMWSSB, reduction in wastage of water, Rain water harvesting, convergence mechanism and role and responsibility of circle level team members and action planning process to be adopted at the ward level.
- Preparation of Location wise events calendar with the participation of the SLF and SHG members
- The action plans should consist of activities proposed to reduce the reduction of the wastage of water and to promote rain water harvesting

Frequency of events: weekly once for next three months

Target Groups to change the behavior :

- RWA members, maid servants,
- watchmen, Drivers, Dhobhis
- Schools and colleges,
- Houses where overflow is observed,
- houses without Bib cocks,
- Houses where washing of cars is observed,
- houses where pipeline linkages are observed, Houses where rain water harvesting pits are not there

Format for action Planning process: (will be added later)

Preparation of Ward wise Action Plans:

Purpose : Reduction of wastage of water and explore the possibility of rain water harvesting ;

1. weekly once the SHG leaders and WaLC volunteers walk the SHSH location to create the awareness
2. Fill in the baseline report and propose the actions to reduce the water wastage in that SHSH location. Based on the situation observed roughly arrive at the quantity of water wasted
3. Explore the possible options to reduce the water wastage and propose the possible actions apart from orienting the households in the reported action plan format
3. Submit the action plans to the concerned to undertake the technical measures if any (eg: replacing a leaking pipe, fixing volves or fixing meters etc)
4. After 4 weeks of continuous education assess the ward situation on the behavior change and the quantity of water wasted.
